other related majors.

II Funding policies for different kinds of talents

For, 1,000 Talents Program, 1,000 Young Talents Program, Yangtze River Scholar, National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars and other talents in national programs, NEU will provide different matching funds. At the same time, our university also sets up some programs such as the Hundred Overseas Talents Program and the High-level Talents Training Program to provide various funding policies for selected candidates. Besides, SBA will also provide some supporting fund for recruited talents.
